

How are Junior High Math Grades Computed?

Components of the Quarter Grade

Test scores A minimum of five tests must be completed each quarter.

Module Lessons - Each student must complete one lesson, test, or lab activity each day.

Labs - The day after each test is completed and passed; students are given one day for a Math Lab.

Quarter Grade

A minimum of five tests must be completed each quarter. The Basic Math grade will be lowered (generally up to 10 points) if the minimum requirement of tests has not been met.

Daily requirements - Each student must complete one lesson, test, or lab activity each day.

Lessons are passed when a score of 85% or higher is achieved. A lesson will be repeated if it is not passed on first or second attempt.

- Grade will be *lowered 10 points* if student fails to meet daily requirements in class.
- Grade will be *raised 10 points* if a student is working above his/her expected grade level for more than 25 days.

Module (lesson) test grades – at the end of every four or five lessons, a test is taken and a percentage grade is given based on student academic performance on that test. Tests are passed when a score of 80% or higher is achieved. Lessons from the previous four or five lessons will be repeated if test is not passed on first or second attempt.

*teacher may modify any of the above procedures for the benefit of the student.

Quarter Grades – Grades are computed at the end of the quarter using a cumulative average of tests taken during the quarter as follows:

- A- 90% or higher
- B- 80%-89%
- C- 70%-79%
- D- 60%-69%
- F- below 60%

***** Expected Book Levels Are as follows *****

7th Grade – 7/6 and 8/7 (if student is in Algebra ½ , Algebra 1, or Algebra 2, basic grade will be raised 5 points.)

8th grade 7/6, 8/7, and Algebra ½ (If student is in Algebra 1 or Algebra 2 basic grade will be raised 5 points.)

Labs

The day after each test is completed and passed; students are given one day for a Math Lab.

Grades will be modified by performance in labs as follows:

Blue Print

3 or more activities completed – Basic grade raised 3 points.

1 or fewer activities completed – Basic grade lowered 3 points.

LOGO

5 or more lessons completed – Basic Grade raised 3 points

3 or fewer lessons completed – Basic Grade lowered 3 points.
