Grading and Expectations

(1 Cor 10:31b NIV) ...whatever you do, do it all for the glory of God.

I. AFFECTIVE/BEHAVIORAL DOMAIN: I can earn a maximum of 5 points each day in P.E. by:

1. Being properly dressed & prepared for class (Includes uniform, socks, shoes, inhalers, braces, orthotics as needed, etc.)
2. Being on time
3. Great Participation/Attitude
4. Encouraging Words
5. Attentive & Respectful During Instruction

II. COGNITIVE DOMAIN: I can earn a maximum of 5 points each day in P.E. by demonstrating knowledge & understanding of the sports/fitness information communicated by the teacher throughout the class.

III. PSYCHO-MOTOR DOMAIN: I can earn a maximum of 5 points each day in P.E. by working to develop and improve my motor skills, physical fitness level, and ability to participate successfully in a variety of sports/activities introduced in class.

IV. POINT DEDUCTIONS: I will **lose 3- 5 points** for things like, but NOT limited to:

1. Talking during teacher instruction
2. Partial Uniform but still able to participate fully in activities (> 3X in a quarter may result in a DETENTION)
3. Pairing Off/Excluding Others
4. Not Paying Attention to the Game/Activity
5. Arguing
6. Being Unkind to others
7. Being tardy (> than 3 "tardies" per qtr may result in Detention)
8. After receiving teacher's instruction, student is not able to demonstrate understanding of the lesson.
9. Lack of effort to perform, develop, or improve physically the required PE activities.
10. Returning to homeroom locker to obtain "tennies" or uniform

I will **lose ALL 15 points** & may be referred Detention for things like, but NOT limited to:

1. Any unexcused absence
2. Being disrespectful
3. Fighting
4. No improvement in behavior after repeated correction
5. No athletic/rubber sole shoes-unable to participate in P.E. (DETENTION after 2nd time in a quarter)

Student PE or Strength/Conditioning grades will NOT be negatively impacted for absences related to GCS Sports Team games or related special events, because of the physical fitness nature of the absence. Any written or special class assignments, however, must be completed as soon as possible, based on schedule criteria provided by the teacher to the student.

Extended illness absences will be addressed by the teacher on an individual student basis.

SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR ILLNESS or INJURY
(1 Cor 10:31b NIV) ...whatever you do, do it all for the glory of God.

I. When you are **unable to participate** fully in PE activities you **MUST:**

1. **Provide a written note from a parent** outlining why full participation is not possible and what specific limitations apply.
2. If full participation is not possible for an extended period, **parent's must provide a written note from the student's physician** outlining a) why full participation is not possible, b) what specific limitations apply & c) when activity may be resumed.
3. If you are unable to participate at all, students will do **one** of the following activities:
 - a) Student will select a PE related topic from the Teacher's Injury/Illness Book. Student will subsequently complete a written assignment related to this topic based on teacher's instructions. If a student is unable to complete one article during class time, the assignment must be completed as homework.
 - b) Student will complete a relationship or health related Bible assignment as specified by the teacher. Incomplete work will be assigned as homework.
 - c) Student will do the hand weight or lower body workout provided by the teacher.
 - d) If recovering from an injury, when provided, student will execute physical therapy exercises in accordance with physician instructions.
 - e) Teacher may assign a study hall at his or her discretion.

II. Special Instructions:

1. No earrings during PE Class EXCEPT studs.
2. No cell phones/Ipods in view during class or they will be taken to the office.
3. Students must change into "tennis shoes" for PE.
4. PE uniform (GCS shirts and shorts) **must** be worn during class.
5. On **FRIDAYS**, students may wear Spirit or Team Shirts during PE.

III. Locks: It is **RECOMMENDED** that students bring a lock from home to be used in the locker room so they can keep "tennies" & uniform available at all times.

IV. Final Instructions:

1. **BRING A FILLED WATER BOTTLE!! (Check water level at lunch)**

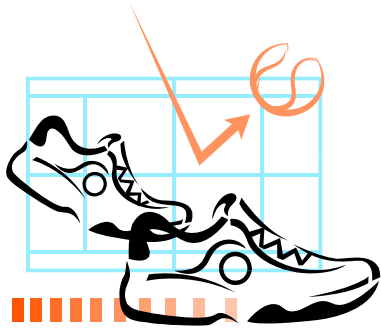
a) If you want your child to carry their inhalers with them to class **YOU MUST** sign a form with Donna Wallace in the office.

*NOTE: In order to earn an "A+" in Girl's PE or Girl's Strength/Conditioning classes, students must consistently display self-motivated behavior, as determined by the teacher, in one or more of the three areas of evaluation.

1. Cognitive Development: This could include researching a fitness or sports-related topic and sharing that information with the class.
2. Psycho-Motor Development: A student should consistently exceed the fitness/sports-related class expectations by doing more than what is required or expanding the challenge without being asked.
3. Behavioral/Affective Development: A Student should consistently exceed the behavioral expectations of class by doing more than what is required in the area of Christian character by demonstrating unsolicited helpfulness, encouragement of others, leadership or serving.
