

High School Human Anatomy & Physiology Grades

Quarter Grades

Grades are computed at the end of the quarter by using a cumulative average of the percentages achieved in four areas of individual student performance in science class. These four areas of focus are as follows:

- **Module (Chapter) test grades** – at end of each chapter a test is taken and a percentage grade is given based on student academic performance on that test
- **Module Quiz** – Each module has an **extra credit** quiz taken before the module test.
- **Daily Written Work (DWW)** – Meeting daily class goals according to check sheet expectations and teacher discretion of these expectations*.
- **Class Preparation** – Having all required materials in class each day

Components of Quarter Grade

Grades are entered and averaged on Ren-web each time students take a test; usually every two or three weeks; depending upon the length of the chapter module. A module quiz taken before the test will also be recorded on Ren-web; one point given for 100% accuracy. If they do not pass the quiz with a 100% score there will be a one point deduction taken away from that module test grade score.

Daily work on check sheets completed during each module is recorded at the same time test scores are recorded. If students have completed their check sheets and study guide reviews by my given target date for taking a module test, and they have come to class prepared with study materials each day, they will receive 25 Daily Work points added to their grade average. Two points will be taken away for each day they are behind, or for every day they come to class not prepared with study materials, ie text books, check sheets, coloring books or any other required materials.

Daily work points are weighted at 25% of grade average. All points given for test scores or module quizzes are weighted at 100% of grade average.

* At the discretion of the teacher, the daily requirements can be modified for an individual student. Students will be clearly informed on any change.

- If a student receives a “C”, “D”, or “F” on a test, the teacher has the **discretion** to have the student make test corrections in the presence of the teacher, re-do part of the module and retake the test, or have the student repeat the module (this includes all module work minus the labs) and retake the test. If a test needs to be re-taken, the new grade earned will be an average of the two test grades.
- All of the requirements of each module must be completed including all lab assignments prior to a test being taken.
- A test taken past the scheduled test date will be a 10 point deduction in the final score.

Module (Chapter) Grades are based on the test grade earned for each module as follows:

- 98-100%** **A+**
- 93-97%** **A**
