

Inductive Bible Study and Scripture Memory

At Gilbert Christian Elementary school, Jesus is spoken of and spoken to (prayer) all day long. Lessons from the scripture are naturally integrated into everything we teach and do; nevertheless, teachers do lead a daily Bible class, and children participate in a topical scripture memory program. In our Bible class the Bible itself is our primary text. Students are taught a step-by-step method of Bible study called *inductive **Bible study***. Gilbert Christian Elementary School boys and girls learn to apply skills of observation, interpretation, and application to the Scriptures. They learn to cross reference and find out how scripture interprets scripture. Students in grades 4 – 6 study the book of John, James, Jonah, Timothy, and Genesis. Learning inductive Bible study skills gives students an opportunity to be lifetime students of the God's word. We use children's materials from Precepts International to instruct students in inductive Bible study, but the Bible is our primary text.
